Associate Program Director, College and Career Success

Position:

The Associate Program Director College and Career Success is a full-time professional dedicated to our students' college and career success. This position plans, facilitates and implements the internship piece of Summer Experience, and is responsible for programming integral to college persistence and completion. The Associate Program Director is engaged directly with our students, Board and program partners and reports to and works closely with the Chief Program Officer.

Responsibilities:

- Maintain existing internship partnerships and cultivate new internship placements that offer a breadth of STEM oriented work experiences;
- Match rising high school seniors to summer internships that will encourage career exploration;
- Coordinate and manage all YouthWorks logistics;
- Provide direct support to ensure college persistence and completion, including informal counseling, campus visits and regular communications;
- Connect college students with campus resources and create campus-based peer groups;
- Engage families in college access, persistence and completion programs and strategies;
- Create programming to support the transition from college to career;
- Advance the goals and objectives of Alumni Council;
- Maintain student database;
- Assist with additional projects as requested.
