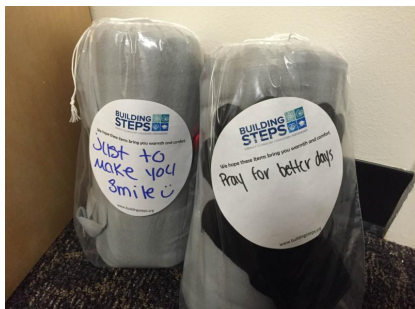


A Step Ahead The Giving Edition November 2017
